Dear New Snails (& New Madeira Parents):

This email has important and updated information about the first few days of school for New Students, beginning on August 23. "Orientation" is an important rite; it takes place formally at the beginning of the year, and informally throughout the year as we are always orienting ourselves to what comes next! We are building a great Orientation schedule, the full details of which will be shared in August. If you get stuck at any point, please reach out and we'll guide and direct you.

For your planning purposes, please be aware that Orientation (and Fall D-Block Tryouts for Athletics & Theatre) for New Students will take place between Friday, August 23 – Tuesday, August 27 including over the weekend. Boarding students move in on Friday, August 23 and are therefore expected to attend activities on all days. Day students are expected to attend activities every day except Sunday, August 25 as noted below. (Note: We have updated our <a href="website">website</a>, as we acknowledge the information below is different than what was originally shared online.)

- Orientation Programming for Students/Parents and Tryouts run from 1:00-5:45pm (including a New Parent Social!)
- Day Families & Boarding Parents depart at 5:45pm
- Dinner and Programming for Boarding Students

### Saturday, August 24: New Student Orientation continues

- Day Students arrive by 9:00am
- New Students participate in on-campus activities in the morning and an off-campus excursion in the afternoon until 5:00pm
- Day Students depart after 5:00pm (and are welcome to stay through dinner until 7:00pm)

Day Students should plan to arrive in time to be seated in the Auditorium for an 8:30am all school
event and are welcome to stay for dinner after D-Block
